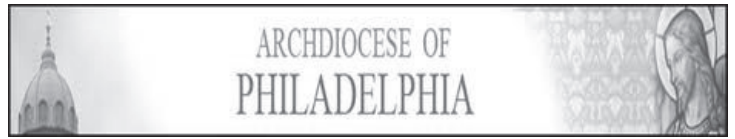


PARISH NEWS
